The support of our donors has made it possible for clients to receive the life-changing programs and services we offer to enable them to remain as independent as possible in spite of their vision loss.


VRS has always placed our clients first, especially in using a community-based model. VRS's specialized teachers provide skills-building instruction in the client's home, school or place of employment. We offer training tailored to each individual's needs.

At the core of our services for individuals with usable vision is the comprehensive Low Vision Evaluation which is conducted by a Low Vision Specialist, an optometrist who is trained in the field of low vision. After a thorough review of the client's medical and vision histories, the Low Vision Specialist conducts an evaluation of the functionality of the client's vision. Devices such as magnifiers, bioptic spectacles, high powered reading glasses, telescopic lenses, glare control tinted glasses and technology equipment may be recommended. The optometrist and the Low Vision Services Director then determine the need for other services in addition to training the client on the use of the device(s). Rehabilitation training, Orientation & Mobility, and Access Technology and computer training may be included, as could be Adjustment to Vision Loss counseling.

To increase our fundraising efforts, we hosted our first annual Race to See in October, 2009 – a 5K race and 1K walk. We were extremely pleased with the turnout (in spite of the rain) and the money we raised by this new initiative. The VRS Board voted unanimously to make Race to See an annual fundraising event.

We are grateful for the generous contributions to our Annual Fund campaign which enables us to direct financial support to programs that might otherwise have to be cut because of decreases from traditional funding sources. The Annual Fund is at the core of our fundraising focus.

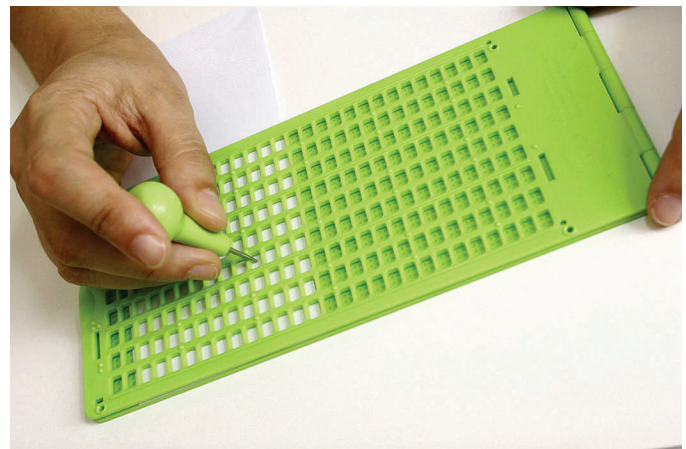

Specific Bequest

I bequeath to Vision Rehabilitation Services of Georgia, Inc., having its principal location at 3830 South Cobb Drive, Suite 125, Smyrna, Georgia 30080, *(insert description of property or item to be left to the organization)* to be used for its exempt purposes.

Restricted Bequest

I bequeath to Vision Rehabilitation Services of Georgia, Inc., having its principal location at 3830 South Cobb Drive, Suite 125, Smyrna, Georgia 30080, the sum of _____ dollars (\$_____) (or _____% of the residue of the property owned by me at my death), to establish a permanent fund to be known as the _____ Fund* on the records of Vision Rehabilitation Services of Georgia, Inc.
